The EU culture funding programme CREATIVE EUROPE reaches its halftime in 2017. After a [public consultation](#) (January 23rd – April 16th), the European Commission will publish a midterm evaluation of the programme until the end of the year. This will be the first step towards a future programme after 2020. To help representatives from the administrative level, policy makers as well as cultural operators to participate in this process – and to celebrate success stories of projects funded by CREATIVE EUROPE CULTURE – we want to give you an insight into the implementation of the programme.

The aim of the CULTURE programme is to support cultural organisations to better adapt to technological developments and to the fact that many face a public funding situation that is getting more restrictive. Cross-sectoral cooperation, transnational exchange and intercultural dialogue, as well as reaching new audiences get increasingly crucial for a strong European cultural landscape in the current situation.

After the presentation of six remarkable cooperation projects from different cultural sectors, all testing new formats, you will have the opportunity to enter into dialogue with experienced project managers and representatives from the European Commission. The reception will give you the chance for an informal exchange. Among others, Creative Europe Desk colleagues from more than 25 countries will attend the event.
