In different European countries there are other similar projects or initiatives that work to make it easier for people with disabilities to come closer to and enjoy culture.</i></p> <p><i>Accessibility services are synchronized by a professional technician. However, there are technological solutions such as COPLA that allow automatic synchronization based on automatic speech recognition.</i></p> <p><i>The project has two parts:</i></p>

	<p>- (1) Carry out a comprehensive study that measures the positive impact of these projects on people with disabilities and the elderly.</p> <p>- (2) Carry out field tests and an analysis of the results to analyze the effectiveness and feasibility of automatic synchronization systems in theater and opera</p> <p>Some of our solutions are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - STARTIT (aptent.es/startit).
